Time Cat's eclectic rock draws from past and present

The Time Cat sound may be influenced by the past, but the band's sound is all its own. The psychedelic and bluesy roots of Jimi Hendrix, The Doors and Jefferson Airplane, as well as strains of punk and grunge, run through the Akron band's original songs.

"We joke about it, and say it's eclectic melancholy," said guitarist and vocalist Jeri Sapronetti, who is also the band's primary songwriter.

Time Cat will be performing at Block 7 Bar & Grill, 524 W. Tuscarawas Ave., at 9 p.m. Friday, Jan.

The Time Cat sound is also founded on geography, Sapronetti said. "Your surroundings and the people that you're playing with and learning from, that's what really creates it, that's what makes the Akron sound. Think about the New York City sound or the Nashville sound. It very much goes with the land."

While the band's music reflects many earlier rock styles, Sapronetti's lyrics are planted firmly in the present. "That epic melancholy kind of thing, it comes from being in this place that's just been economically depressed for so long," she said.

The social reality of the area influences her songs. "A lot of friends have passed away from drug overdoses, just so many people. It's commonplace. It's sad," she added.

Sapronetti finds solace through songwriting. "Because I can't deal with
